Updates since last meeting

The formal announcement of the establishment of the group was distributed on the 13th August. We received lots of positive comments about the establishment including from Ruth Crowder, Hazel Powell, as well as from several people in the mental health and vulnerable groups team in Welsh Government. We also received positive

feedback from the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges and several of its members; Health Education and Improvement Wales and from the NHS Wales Collaborative.

The Senedd Committees for Children and Young People, and for Health acknowledged the establishment of the group and expressed that they would be keen to hear from us in future.

Actions since last meeting

We've had contact from Allan Wardough, who is leading on the work of the National Clinical Framework and keen to update and consult with the group.

Liz Williams has also drafted a response to the Health Committee of priorities for the Senedd term, Liz is keen to hear of views on CYP and others who may not have yet responded. The deadline for the consultation responses is the 17th Sep.

Last meeting

At the last meeting (14th Sep) we had a presentation from Craig Lawton (BMA Cymru) on work and evaluation of surveys they've produced on current pressures upon staff, as well as pressures experienced through earlier stages of the pandemic.

Updates since last meeting

The group was referenced in the papers that were presented at the Welsh Government's Social Prescribing Task & Finish Group meeting. It was noted in the document that Welsh Government could feed in thoughts on SP to this group and ask for feedback on the National Framework.

Welsh Government are keen that the group is consulted during the development of the next mental health strategy, and also in evaluation of the current strategy. The evaluation for the current strategy has been commissioned to 'Opinion Research Services' (www.ors.org.uk)

Liz Williams submitted responses to the Health, Social Care & Sport Committee as well as the Children, Young People & Education Committee, on priorities for the Senedd term, on behalf of the group. There was a good number of members of this group who endorsed those documents.

Last meeting

Kerri Eilertsen-Feeney, Dr Push Mangat and Lisa Llewelyn (all HEIW) gave an update on the development of the Mental Health Workforce Plan. There was also an item on prospective work on staff wellbeing.

Updates since last meeting

Welsh Government had highlighted that they will be establishing a clinical advisory group and offered the opportunity for the RCMHEAG to have representation on the group. The draft ToR and information will be shared with members once received.

Actions since last meeting

It was agreed to consider a joint response on the Senedd Health Committee inquiry on the impact of Covid on Health and Social Care. This may be drafted in the new year.

At the last meeting, several representatives from HEIW presented an update on the development of the Mental Health Workforce Plan. The slides from the presentation had been received and it was agreed to write formally to HEIW in feeding back on the presentation.

There hadn't been enough time to consider discuss the prospective work on staff wellbeing at the meeting, that will be updated over email and discussed at an upcoming meeting.

Members have been asked to provide any case studies to further highlight joint working across services. A case study on support for early diagnosis of dementia will be shared with the group to help inform.
